The workspace design at 4PSQ enables an agile way of working, with a variety of work settings to choose from.

We are adopting an AGILE working environment

- Dedicated spaces for your team referred to as a neighbourhood
- An array of open spaces designed to facilitate collaboration and interaction
- Unassigned seating to encourage movement, collaboration and connectivity within your team neighbourhood
- Smaller enclosed spaces which support high-focus work, formal meetings or confidential conversations
- Electronic sit to stand desks (work points) to support employee health and wellbeing.
- A state-of-the-art building with accessibility and inclusion front of mind. Four Paramatta Square has been designed with built-in accessibility and inclusive features, including Visual Accessible signage, hearing loops on each floor and main entrance and path of travel accessible to all employees.
- Parent rooms, First Aid rooms and Multi-Faith rooms on multiple floors
- Curved screens provide a pleasant yet subtle immersion effect, which focuses on you at the centre of your desk.
- You can work on four applications at any one time on the one screen.
- On each village there is a central floor that features a marketplace with kitchen amenities and a social space for people to connect.

A Sustainable Building equals a healthy environment

Four Parramatta Square is a unique opportunity for us to deliver leading environmental performance. We are seeking a 5.5 star NABERS energy tenancy rating without GreenPower and 6 stars with GreenPower by 2021. This will exceed the Government's Resource Efficiency Policy (GREP) target of 5 star NABERS.

A number of energy efficiency opportunities have been integrated into the design and fit out including energy efficient LED lighting, sensors and solar panels. In addition to the NABERS rating, Four Parramatta Square is also targeting 5 star Greenstar a more holistic sustainability rating for design, fit out and operations.





Experience Indigenous history and culture

The Burramatta people, of the Darug nation, lived, hunted, gathered, danced and painted in Parramatta for at least 40,000 years before European arrival. There are many places where visitors can learn about Darug culture where a wealth of bush food and medicinal plants grow. These spots provide a window into one of the world's oldest surviving cultures.

Get Active

Parramatta is the perfect place to ride a bike - the area is reasonably flat and has good cycle links to greater Sydney.

Roads and Maritime have produced an interactive Cycleway Finder that will help you plan the best route to ride to Four Parramatta Square!

Cyclists and pedestrians can now travel on a high-quality, river front path from Parramatta Park to Sydney Olympic Park following the official opening of the Subiaco Creek link.

If you are riding, running or biking to work Four Parramatta Square will offer first class End of Trip facilities.

End of Trip Facilities

End of Trip facilities include 580 lockers, 505 secure bike parks and 59 showers.

Secure tenant end of trip facilities are integrated into the Four Parramatta Square basement with a dedicated bicycle access ramp from Macquarie Street. Facilities include lockers, secure bike parks and showers
