

As per Clause 2.1 and 2.2 in Appendix 2 in the [TAFE NSW Temporary Teachers – Conditions of Employment – Procedures](#) the following priority assessments apply:

For internal candidates;

This position is available only to long serving part time casual teachers and/or TAFE Temporary Teachers within (campus/region where vacancy exists). That is, applicants who have worked at (campus/region where vacancy exists) as a part time casual teacher and/or TAFE Temporary Teacher for 240 hours or more (on average) for two consecutive years or more, as at the closing date for application.

For external candidates;

Applications will be considered in order of priority as follows:

- i. Applicants who meet the service requirements to be considered as a “long serving part time casual teachers and/or TAFE Temporary Teachers” (as defined below) through service within (campus/region where vacancy exists); then*
- ii. Applicants who meet the service requirements to be considered as a “long serving part time casual teachers and/or TAFE Temporary Teachers” (as defined below), partly through service in (campus/region where vacancy exists) and partly through service in other campuses/regions; then*
- iii. Applicants who meet the service requirements to be considered as a “long serving part time casual teacher and/or TAFE Temporary Teacher” (as defined below), through service in one campus/region (other than (campus/region where vacancy exists))*
- iv. All other applicants, including external applicants.*

For the purpose of (i) to (iii) above, applicants will qualify as a “long serving part time casual teacher and/or TAFE Temporary Teacher” where they have worked as a part time casual teacher and/or TAFE Temporary Teacher for 240 hours or more (on average) for two consecutive years or more, as at the closing date of application. Service must be rendered in the relevant campus or region as specified in (i) to (iii) above.
