

## Teaching Qualifications required to work at TAFE NSW

For recruitment into a teaching position in TAFE NSW you need to show:

- Appropriate subject knowledge, skills and vocational qualifications in the discipline you plan to be teaching and a commitment to maintain technical currency (**Industry Qualifications and/or experience**).
- Minimum of three years post-qualification experience in industry relevant to your qualifications in the discipline you plan to be teaching, gained no longer than five years previously (**Industry Currency**).

**AND have the appropriate teaching qualifications** as spelled out below. In some cases a teacher can be brought in under supervision while they attain their teaching qualifications. [Clauses 1.13-1.16 – Employ skilled Trainers and Assessors](#)

You need to hold **one** of the following:

4	<p>A credential issued by a higher education provider (as defined by section 16-1 <a href="#">of the Higher Education Support Act 2003</a> which would enable the individual to satisfy the academic requirements for registration as a secondary school teacher in accordance with the registration requirements in at least one State or Territory summarised as ‘Australian Secondary School Teaching qualifications’, plus the following:  Assessor skill set TAESS00011 or TAESS00019 (or its successor)  OR  VET delivered to School Students Teacher Enhancement Skill Set TAESS00024 (or its successor)  ‘Australian Secondary School Teaching Qualifications’ usually contain one of the following types of wording:  Bachelor of Education (Secondary)  Bachelor of Teaching (Secondary)  Bachelor of Education (K-12 Teaching)  Master of Secondary Teaching  Master of Teaching in Secondary Education  Master of Applied Learning and Teaching (Secondary)  Master of Learning and Teaching (Secondary)  Master of Teaching (Secondary)</p>
5	<p><b>Assessor Only</b>  Assessor skill set TAESS00011 or TAESS00019 (or its successor)  TAESS00001 plus (TAEASS502 or TAEASS502A or TAEASS502B) or  TAE40110 plus (TAEASS502 or TAEASS502A or TAEASS502B) or  TAEASS401 plus TAEASS402 plus TAEASS502 plus TAEASS403 or  TAEDES411 plus TAEASS412 plus TAEASS413</p>
6	<p><b>Teaching under Supervision</b>  Under exceptional circumstances a teacher may be recruited without teaching qualifications or with only partial qualifications shown within categories 1-5. They then undertake work under the supervision of a qualified teacher while they attain the required qualifications.</p>
