POSITION CONTEXT

• Work under limited supervision and provides guidance to other team members when required.

- Drive and/or operate one of the current Rural Linemarking Services fleet of linemarking machines to an acceptable standard.
- Operate a light vehicle or rigid truck as part of a mobile traffic control configuration to provide protection for other team members on high speed, high traffic volume roads.
- Assist other team members in the maintenance, set-up, pack-up and de-canting for the linemarking machine.

 Assist the Work Supervisor and Team Leader in the application of all quality, safety and environmental processes to ensure the relevant Roads and Maritime Services policies are met.

ESSENTIAL REQUIREMENTS

- Possession of Construction Industry Certification (White Card) and Traffic Controllers Tickets (Blue and Yellow Tickets).
- Ability to work as a member of a team.
- Ability to work in close proximity to traffic.
- Ability to effectively communicate with members of the public, external providers and staff at all levels in both oral and written form.
- Ability and willingness to undertake labouring tasks.
- Ability and willingness to acquire certification for other relevant machinery as required.
- It is a prerequisite that applicants possess a current motor vehicle driver licence.
- The successful applicant may be required to work outside normal working hours or to travel on occasion.
- The successful applicant will be required to undergo relevant security and criminal records check prior to appointment.
- Applicants must be prepared to be assessed against "Road-worker Grade 2" and "Linemarker Grade1" compulsory competencies plus a number of elective competencies within 3 months of appointment (The following information relates to the relevant competencies).

To progress to this position (Linemarker Grade 1) a staff member must meet the following criteria:

- Possess all the requirements for Road Worker Grade 2; and
- Meet all of the Linemarker Grade 1 Compulsory Competencies; and
- Meet 2 of the Linemarker Grade 1 Elective Competencies

Road Worker 2 possesses a variety of labouring skills and knowledge of work process. The staff member is competent in a number of specific activities and can perform them with a degree of autonomy, requiring less direct supervision that at Level 1. Staff member performs tasks that require development of specific competencies above those of routine labouring. Progression to Grade 2 requires the staff member to:

- Possess all the compulsory competencies for Road Worker Grade 1
- Meet all the Road Worker Grade 2 compulsory competencies
- Meet 5 of the Road Worker Grade 2 elective competencies
