





What are Mobile Data Terminals?

Mobile Data Terminals (MDTs) are touch screen tablets installed in NSW RFS appliances that will enable two-way, real-time sharing of incident intelligence between members in the field and IMTs improving both dispatch and response performance.

What are the benefits?

FOR FIRST RESPONDERS

MDTs will **provide you with up-to-date** incident information in the field that is currently unavailable through existing NSW RFS systems, allowing you to be best prepared when responding to an incident. These features include crewing, map and navigation features including navigable fire trails, IAPs, BIRS forms and ability to view the ETA of other responding vehicles.

FOR INCIDENT CONTROLLERS AND IMTS

MDTs allows you to send and receive real-time incident information to and from the fireground, enabling better pre-incident preparation and decision making in the field.

FOR NSW RFS SYSTEMS

MDTs enable automatic incident information sharing between existing NSW RFS systems including CAD and ICON, reducing the number of manual processes for members to access, share and report on incident information.
